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## **IRS Updates Benefit Plan Limits for 2020**

The IRS recently updated the following benefit plan limits for **2020** to adjust for inflation:

- Flexible Spending Accounts & Parking and Transit Accounts
- Health Savings Accounts

PARKING & TRANSIT ACCOUNTS (monthly)	\$265	\$270	

<sup>\*</sup>The updated IRS limits will apply to plans beginning on or after **January 1, 2020**.

<sup>\*</sup>Employers are <u>not required</u> to update their plans to allow for the new limits. Employers may choose to cap employee contributions to an amount lower than the IRS maximum.
