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As a result of the Department of Labor's latest [guidance](#) requiring employers to notify remote employees of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) paid leave provisions, Benefit Review Services, Inc. has posted the employer notice on BRSi Online for all of our clients that are currently utilizing the platform.

If you are currently using BRSi Online, this will satisfy your obligation to notify any employees that are currently working remotely.

Please Note: You will still be required to post physical copies of the notice in your office once your office is able to reopen.
