

CAA Prescription Drug Data Collection Reporting (RxDC)

The Consolidated Appropriations Act (CAA) was passed into law with the purpose of adding transparency and consumerism into health plans. As noted in the BRSi December 15, 2021 Compliance Alert, [The Consolidated Appropriations Act \(CAA\) and the No Surprises Act \(NSA\)](#), there are many new health plan reporting requirements that apply to all health plans. Most of these requirements have been completed by your insurance carrier and/or TPA/administrator.

One of the reporting requirements of the CAA is the Prescription Drug Data Collection Reporting (RxDC). The required reports include health care spending, top 50 drug lists, prescription drug rebates, and fees. Plan year 2022 data must be submitted to CMS by June 1, 2023.

Your Insurance carrier/administrator (PBM if you have an Rx carve out) will complete and submit the filings for you. However, most carriers/administrators do not have your cost-sharing data (employee/employer premium contributions) which is required to complete the filing. As a result, in the next few days you will be receiving an RxDC Data Collection questionnaire from your carrier/administrator (if you have not already received a notice). Please complete and return the questionnaire by the deadline they have listed on their request.

The questionnaire is simple to complete. Your carrier/administrator will need to know:

1. The average monthly premium paid by member.
2. The average monthly premium paid by you, the employer.
3. Your funding arrangement (fully-insured or self-funded).
4. Your legal name.

Once you submit the completed questionnaire to your carrier/administrator, your carrier/administrator will then add your data to their full submission report and submit your required data to CMS on your Plan's behalf.

Important: If you do not complete the RxDC questionnaire and provide your premium cost sharing info to your carrier/administrator by their stated deadline, you will be responsible for reporting this information (directly) to CMS by the June 1, 2023 filing deadline.
